

## ***Dendropsophus ebraccatus***

Ebraccata / Hourglass Tree Frog

---

*Distribution:* Central American Rainforest

*Habitat:* Arboreal species that inhabits rainforest and woodland habitats near pond and stream areas.

*Size:* 1.25" - 2"

*Trade availability:* Somewhat scarce (captive bred)

### **Captive Care**

*Space:* A 10-15 gallon high or 18x18x18 Exo Terra is suitable for 5-6 adults.

*Substrate:* Peat sphagnum (at a 2-3" depth) with an inch of pea gravel (or similar) underneath for drainage.

*Plants:* Live, dense plants such as pothos, philodendron, monstera, and syngonium as well as moss covered logs are good for this species.

*Water:* A large, shallow water dish with distilled water is recommended for soaking. Mist the enclosure daily to keep humidity high.

*Temperature:* Day temperatures from 74°-80°F  
Night temperatures around 68-72°F

*Humidity:* 80% covered, 20% ventilated is recommended. Glass, plexiglass, or Saran Wrap on a screen lid works well.

*Lighting:* 2% UVB for 12-14 hours a day is required for frogs 2 months and older, no more than 3% UVB. UVB is essential for the frog's growth! It will also help eliminate excess bacteria growth in the tank.

*Food:* Juveniles: Hydei fruit flies and 1/8" crickets  
Adults: 1/4" crickets and wax worms

Dust all food with a 3:1 ratio of Rep-Cal Herptivite to Rep-Cal Calcium with Vitamin D3.
