Theloderma pictus

Cinnamon Tree Frog

Distribution: Vietnam

Habitat: Tree dweller often found on the bark of trees overhanging water and in holes in the tree.

Size: 3" - 3.5"

Trade availability: Scarce



Captive Care

Space: A 10-15 gallon long or 18x18x18 Exo Terra is suitable for 3 adults.

Substrate: Rocks or branches forming about $\frac{1}{4}$ to $\frac{1}{3}$ of the tank as land.

Plants: Live, dense plants such as pothos and philodendron.

Water: A highly aquatic species, approximately ²/₃ to ³/₄ of the tank should be water. Run a pump from one

side of the terrarium over a pile of rocks to form a waterfall, this creates constant humidity and

biological filtration.

Temperature: Day temperatures no higher than 78°F

Night temperatures around 65-70°F

Humidity: 90% covered, 10% ventilated is recommended. Glass, plexiglass, or Saran Wrap on a screen lid works

well.

Lighting: 2% UVB for 12-14 hours a day is required for frogs 2 months and older, no more than 3% UVB.

UVB is essential for the frog's growth! It will also help eliminate excess bacteria growth in the tank.

Food: Juveniles: 1/8" - 1/4" crickets

Adults: 1/4" crickets and similarly sized roaches

Dust all food with a 3:1 ratio of Rep-Cal Herptivite to Rep-Cal Calcium with Vitamin D3.
