

Trachycephalus resinifictrix

Amazon Milky Frog

Distribution: Amazon Basin

Habitat: Tree dweller that is often found on the bark of trees.

Size: 3" - 3.5"

Trade availability: Scarce (captive bred)



Captive Care

Space: A 29 gallon high or 24x18x24 Exo Terra is suitable for 2-3 adults.

Substrate: Peat sphagnum (1/4" depth).

Plants: Live, dense plants such as pothos, ficus, and philodendron as well as branches for climbing. Seems to enjoy branches hanging over water.

Water: A large, shallow water dish with distilled water is recommended for soaking.

Temperature: Day temperatures no higher than 82°F
Night temperatures around 68-70°F

Humidity: 80% covered, 20% ventilated is recommended. Glass, plexiglass, or Saran Wrap on a screen lid works well.

Lighting: 2% UVB for 10-12 hours a day is required for frogs 2 months and older, no more than 3% UVB. UVB is essential for the frog's growth! It will also help eliminate excess bacteria growth in the tank.

Food: Small froglets: 1/8" crickets
Juveniles: 1/4" crickets
Adults: 3/4" crickets and similarly sized roaches

Dust all food with a 3:1 ratio of Rep-Cal Herptivite to Rep-Cal Calcium with Vitamin D3.
